'Working with Suicidal Ideation in Clients'

Introduction

This workshop is aimed at Diploma students and counsellors and psychotherapists who wish to improve their confidence when faced with suicidal ideation or intent in their clients. The workshop has a personal development focus with a number of experiential exercises and challenges to facilitate exploration in a safe space. The deepest and darkest places may contain gateways to the most profound and joyful transformations and it becomes a privilege to work with clients at such depth.

The Facilitator

John Dykes was for many years a Samaritan and latterly a trainer of Samaritans. This was followed by training in Gestalt and some time in practice as a Gestalt therapist. Also, as a long-time student of meditation and ki-aikido, John is interested in noticing that as we ourselves change so too the quality of our personal, professional and wider relationships also changes. Our capacity to work with others is dependent on our capacity to be with ourselves.

Venue

The workshop will take place at St Michael's Centre in Stoke Gifford, Bristol. St Michael's is easily accessible by road and public transport. Six miles north of Bristol City Centre, three miles from the M4, M5 and M32 motorways, and about five minutes walk from Parkway Railway Station.

Refreshments

Tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided during the day. Bring your own lunch - alternately there is a small coffee shop on site, or two supermarkets and a pub a few minutes walk away.

Cost

The cost of this workshop is **£80 per person** - or **£50 per person** for students, volunteer counsellors and volunteer supervisors. *"Early bird discount" of £10 for bookings made and paid for by Friday 20th October 2017.*
