Network Training offers **two introductory courses** in listening skills/counselling, one of which can also be delivered to outside organisations in a flexible workshop format to meet their specific training needs.



Introduction

What happens when sex is talked about in a therapeutic situation?

Sexuality is a universal fundamental human drive. Every person has a relationship with sex in some way. Sex goes straight to the heart of human vulnerability. Sex incites some of the most powerful emotions. Understanding what happens when sex is talked about allows the subject to be explored within counselling professions.

How do conversations about sex fit into the therapeutic setting? What is erotic transference? What language should I use? This workshop will consider these questions and more.

Working with couples at Relate for ten years, Olivia noticed the significant impact sexual issues can have on relationship happiness and individual well-being.
