'Working with trauma in the counselling room'

Introduction

Do you ever wonder why some clients get stuck more, seem less able to retain information and try out changes than others?

Do you ever feel like you are "missing something" when working with a client?

Do you ever get overwhelmed with feelings when working with a particular client?

These MAY be indicators that you are working with trauma.

In this training day we will explore:

- What is trauma
- Ways to recognise trauma
- Different ways to work with trauma
- Resources we can share with clients
- Some information on attachment and dissociation can impact counselling clients who have experienced trauma.

The day will be a mixture of teaching, individual reflection and group discussion based around research and my own experiences of being a counsellor, supervisor and agency director.

The Facilitator

Tanya Orr is a qualified and accredited counsellor, supervisor and trainer who holds a particular interest in trauma, attachment and dissociation.

Following her curiosity of the impact that trauma has on the body, she decided to train in Sensorimotor Psychotherapy. She has since integrated this approach into her counselling model and has found this provides profound hope for those struggling with trauma.

Whilst in Northern Ireland with her family, Tanya co-established an agency 'Restore Counselling' based in Belfast. She is currently the Executive Director of 'The Willows Counselling Service' in Swindon, Trustee of the 'Swindon Counselling and Psychotherapy Network' and chair of 'tag' (trauma and abuse group).
